HOW TO SCORE YOURSELF

If the characteristic is never true put an x in the box under never. Then place a "0" in the points column.

If true only on rare occasions put an x in the box under seldom and put a "1" in the points column.

If true sometimes (49 per cent) put an x under sometimes and put a "2" in the points column.

If true 50 to 75 % of the time, put the x under usually and put a "3" in the points column

If true most of the time put the x under mostly and put a "4" in the points column

Finally if true of you all the time put the x under always and put a "5" in the points column.

Now add up your total score in the points column.

The higher the score the stronger the gift.

When doing the second worksheet showing the problem area for each gift, scores the same.

The lower the score the more mature

0-5 points = mature

6-10 = growing in grace

10-15 = average

16-20 = immature

21-25 = needs help
